Make Observations	Gather as much information as you can, fill out the incident report, and mail it to Snowlands Network. We will see that your report is forwarded to the appropriate law enforcement authority.
Avoid Confrontation	Under no circumstances should you confront violators or take the law into your own hands.
Take Photos or Videos	Please provide us with photo or video evidence if available.
Ask Friends to Help	Pass copies of this form to your friends and ask them to help in this important effort to provide documentation of motorized impacts on human-powered winter recreation and wildlands.
